The inaugural ceremony started with a prayer service followed by lighting of the lamp by Most Rev. Bishop Henry D'Souza, the Chairman, Fr. Deepak Thomas KJ, NYD, Sr. Darshana, and Ms. Anancia, RYLA Representatives, Fr. Raymond, RYD Representative, Mr. Sijo Ambatt, ICYM President and Ms. Jenny Joy, ICYM Genreal Secretary and the council was officially declared open.

Fr. Deepak Thomas officially welcomed the gathering, followed by the releasing of the convention prayer by Bishop Henry D'Souza and was prayed.

Mr. Sijo Ambat ICYM National President chaired the meeting and called for the the Quorum. Since there was no quorum the meeting was adjourned as per the constitution for 15 minutes and then the proceedings of the meeting began after 15 minutes.

Ms. Leema Lakra NYS-II read the minutes of 40th Council Meeting. With Certain clarifications and corrections it was approved by the members of the council. Mr. Amit Lakra, RYP, M.P. Region proposed and Mr. Manoj John, RYR, Chhattisgarh Region seconded the minute.

Agenda 1: YUVAGRAM

Mr. Felix Kumar Ekka, NYSP II presented the proposed plan of starting up a selffinancing project i.e. poultry farming at YUVAGRAM. Members cautioned the pros and cons with regard to the proposed plan and gave the approval for the proposed plan. There were also suggestions that a permanent set up should be arranged at least with 5 washrooms and a capacity of accommodating minimum of 30 youth. It was further suggested that the local families can be involved to help the functioning.

Agenda 2: Regional Visits

The national team presented the tentative regional visit plan and informed the council that every region would be visited. The council suggested that the annual calendar of every region can be obtained and the visits can be planned accordingly. It was suggested that during the visit NEXCOs can plan for a day's session.

Agenda 3: Creation of Zones

In order to increase interaction among regions, the National team proposed the idea of creation of zones and conducting competitions at zonal and national level. The proposed zones were:

- 1. North Zone Northern Region and UP Region
- 2. West Zone Western Region
- 3. East Zone Jharkhand Region, Bihar and WB & Sikkim
- 4. Central Zone- M P, Chhattisgarh and Odessa region
- 5. North East Zone North East Region
- 6. South zone Telugu, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Kerala region

The competitions proposed were Choreography, Group Singing, Short Film Making, Essay Writing and sports events.

After detailed discussion on the agenda topic, it was decided that it is better to have competition at the regional level itself and after NYC. NEXCO will be deciding on the dates and the competitions after receiving the annual calendar from the regions. In accordance with the annual program schedule common competitions can be conducted. Bishop Henry also suggested that one competition can be conducted wherein a youth is trained through public speaking.

Agenda 4: Apna Yuva Spandan

National team presented the new format of the Bi-Monthly newsletter along with the subscription form. It was informed that Ms. Jenny Joy will be the new Editor and the reports and articles can be sent to the email id generalsecretary@icym.net. It was also informed that the magazine will be focussed on a particular theme related to youth and the magazine will be made more informative for the youth. A suggestion was made that a survey can be conducted among the youth to precisely know what the youth is expecting from Apna Yuva Spandan

It was also said that newsletter should be subscribed at the diocesan level. Fr. Deepak Thomas, NYD also informed that the magazine will be sent internationally in the form of e-newsletter.

Agenda 5: National Youth Convention

1. NYC Logo

NEXCO presented the logos which were received through the Logo competition. A Logo Committee was formed in order to finalize the logo from the available options following which it will be sent to the national office. The committee will be headed by Fr. Raymond Rumao, RYD, Western Region.

2. NYC Theme Song

Mr. Vipin, RYP, Karnataka informed that a committee has been formed and the work is in progress. Fr. Mari, RYD, Karnataka, (joined the council on the second day) briefed about the preparation of NYC by the region. With regard to the theme song and its recording, he informed the proposed budget. In response the council suggested that we can cut the cost by involving the youth for singing other than employing the professional singers. Karnataka region agreed to bear the cost of recording and the same will be deducted from the financial contribution from Karnataka region towards NYC. The song will be sent to National Office by the end of August.

3. Days in Diocese (DID)

On request of the youth the decision regarding not organising Days in Diocese was reconsidered. It was decided that Fr. Mari, RYD, Karnataka after consulting Regional DYDs will be communicating the final decision to the National Office.

4. NYC Committees

NEXCOs along with other council members decided the person in charge of various committees for NYC. The local committees will be formed by the region and the same will be notified to the national office.

5. NYC Finance

The proposed budget for the fourth coming NYC is Rs. 1 Crore. The National team agreed to contribute 10 Lakhs. Alumni agreed to contribute Rs. 1 Lakh. Suggestions were made that in order to raise funds, parishes can have Sunday collections for convention and sponsorships can be sought. It was also recommended that Chairman Bishop could draft a letter addressing the hierarchy to assist in raising the funds.

- Budget will be around 1 Crore and 50% will be given by local Diocese and Region
- Registration fee will be Rs.500 only
