Dear Archbishop/Bishops, Directors, Coordinators, and Youth Leaders,

Greetings from the KRCBC Youth Commission, Bangalore!

KRCBC- Youth Commission after having organized 11 Regional Conventions successfully is ready to organize its 12th Regional Youth Convention (YUVAJANOTSAVA - 2022) which goes by the theme **"SPRINGS"-Called to be free, to Grow, and to Serve** from 22-25 October 2022 at Christ School Auditorium in Bangalore. The Karnataka Region organizes Youth Conventions once a two-year, which will be hosted by different dioceses in the Region. This year the 12th YUVAJANOTSAVA-2022 will be hosted by the Diocese of Mandya.

The previous YUVAJANOTSAVA was in the Diocese of Bellary in 2019. About 2000 youth participated in the Convention. The 12th Regional Youth Convention which was supposed to be organized in the year 2021 postponed due to the pandemic. However, this year the Diocese of Mandya has come forward to host the YUVAJANOTSAVA-2022. The Regional Executive Committee (REXCO) team will take leadership in organizing the YUVAJANOTSAVA in association with the hosting diocesan executive team. The preparation has begun, three preparatory meetings have taken place with the hosting diocese and the committees have been drafted in the council.

Main highlights & guidelines of the upcoming YUVAJANOTSAVA 2022

1. Theme:

The 12th Regional Youth Convention theme is "SPRINGS"-Called to be



Free, to Grow and to Serve. Another means facilitating the youth to identify the springs of water within, to make them free from all kinds of addictions and helping them to grow in the Spirit to become true servers of the society.

2. Convention Cross:

The Convention Cross is sent to all the dioceses and movements given



for the upcoming YUVAJANOTSAVA 2022. The convention cross all goes to the parishes and institutions to summon all the youth to participate in the YUVAJANOTSAVA. The mite collected in the dumb box

collection is divided as follows: 50% towards the expenses of the Convention; 25% to the Regional office; 25% to the Diocesan office.

On the Inaugural day of YUVAJANOTSAVA-2022 i.e., 22-10-2022, all youth will march towards the venue with their respective diocese/movements in procession carrying the Convention Cross. It is advised to bring banners, and flags with names and logos that symbolize their diocese/movement. You are encouraged to make this procession even more creative by presenting the Youth in ethnic wear.

3. Convention Prayer:

The YUVAJANOTSAVA-2022 prayer card is attached along with this



mail. Make use of it individually and as well as in group prayers and especially when the youth are gathered. As the preparation for the convention is on various levels, we need your spiritual support too for the success of the Convention.

4. Registration fee:

The YUVAJANOTSAVA 2022 registration is OPEN NOW on the Official Website kindly log on to www.kryc.org. Follow the kryc.org Mobile App for more information. The registration web portal is classified into individual Youth, Groups/Bulk, Priests, Nuns, and volunteers. There



will be "no on-spot registrations" accepted to avoid last-minute hurdles. Kindly note that a Registration Code **Number** will be sent to the individual's registered Email ID. Save the number or take a print of the Registration Code Numbers and submit it to the Registration Counters at the Convention venue to check in and collect the welcome kit bags. The Registration fee is Rs. 500/-. Last Date of Registration 30th September 2022. registration will not be accepted after the last date. 5. RYC Participants:

The YUVAJANOTSAVA is a Youth Convention, wherein thousands of youths across Karnataka gather under one roof. It's an opportunity for the youth to mingle with each other, to know the culture, and collaborate. However, each diocese and movement have a restricted number to participate i.e., 5 youths from each parish and 100 youths from each movement. There is no restriction on numbers for the participants from the hosting diocese of Mandya and the Archdiocese

6. Regional Youth Awards:

The YUVAJANOTSAVA 2022 enables us to identify and appreciate our youth leaders who have made a difference in society and in Karnataka Region at large. The Regional Youth Awards is a benchmark in the YUVAJANOTSAVA to nominate young achievers to receive the award. More details will be sent to the directors separately.

7. Cultural Programmes:

The dioceses and the movements are encouraged to give cultural performances in YUVAJANOTSAVA-2022 on the theme "SPRINGS" highlighting the youth to come out from their various kinds of addictions and spread social awareness. Each diocese and movement will be allotted 5-7 min to give their performances. I request the directors and animators to prepare your youth to give a cultural program based on the theme.

8. Exhibition Stall:

The exhibition stall will be put up in the convention venue wherein the dioceses and movements, are requested to make use of it to exhibit their ethnicity, cultures, articles, etc. Posters, achievements, T-shirts, etc. of your diocese/movements can also be exhibited in the stalls. To book the stalls, kindly inform the regional team (REXCO) prior.

9. Peace Rally:

A Mega Youth Rally will take place on the 2nd day of the Convention i.e., on 23rd Oct 2022, Sunday. This is a rally for about 4kms around the Convention venue, holding the high message of Peace & Harmony. About 5000+ youth are expected to participate in the rally and is all set to make a statement of solidarity, love, unity, peace & harmony among the youngsters. Directors/Animators are advised to prepare your Youth for the Rally.

10. Alumni Registration:

Considering the selfless contribution to the ICYM Movement in the diocese and Karnataka at large the KRYC welcomes the ABIDE members (ICYM past members) to participate in the YUVAJANOTSAVA-2022. They need to register to participate in the event. It would be appreciable to form ABIDE Group in the diocese which would become great support as well as a resource to the movement.

11. Raffle Tickets:

The Regional team has come forward with initiatives to raise funds for the convention by selling raffle tickets/lucky-draw tickets throughout Karnataka. The ticket cost is Rs. 50/- only. It's a small contribution towards Convention and in return, attractive prizes will be awarded to the winners. The regional team has conducted an online meeting with all the diocesan presidents to help us in this regard. I humbly request the Archbishop/Bishops, Excellencies, Directors, and Animators your kind self to support us to sell the raffle tickets in every parishes/institution in your dioceses and movements.

12. YOUTHSAV:

We are delighted to inform you that the Karnataka Regional Youth



Commission presents "YOUTHSAV-22" youth a celebration the joyous on occasion of YUVAJANOTSAVA 2022. It's an online cultural event that will begin on 28th August 2022, until 25thSeptember 2022. It's also an opportunity to get out of their comfort zones and show their hidden talents. The YOUTHSAV -22 includes online competitions which are comprised of Painting, Singing, Dance, Elocution, and many more. The participants need to register for the events. I request the directors and animators encourage to youth to take part in all the

cultural events. Registration fees: Solo events Rs. 50/- per person, Group events Rs. 200/- per group. All details about registration and guidelines of the events will be shared through E-mail, social media, website www.kryc.com

13. YUVAJANOTSAVA CUP:

On the occasion of YUVAJANOTSAVA 2022, the Regional team is organizing YUVAJANOTSAVA CUP 2022, a sports event to lift the

youthful spirits high and also to promote the Convention. The 2 games conducted in this event are Volleyball (for Boys) and Throwball (for Girls). The YUVAJANOTSAVA CUP is a one-day sports event that is scheduled to be conducted on Sunday, 4th September 2022, at St. Philomena's College, Puttur, Mangalore.

This event is hosted by ICYM Mangalore Diocese. I request the directors



and animators to send 1 team for Volleyball and 1 Throwball team for representing your respective diocese movements. Registration fees: Rs. 1000/-(per diocese/movement, for Volleyball both & Single Throwball), event registration fee will be Rs. 500/-(per diocese/movement, for event). All details about registration and guidelines of the events will be shared

through E-Mail, Social media, and the website www.kryc.com.

I request all directors and animators of each diocese and movement to encourage and help every Youth to take active participation in Yuvajanotsava 2022. Also kindly share this information with the respective Youth Leaders and advise them to be prepared and jointly make necessary preparations for the Convention.
