Chaplains and Animators Training (CAT) Programme:

CAT (Chaplains & Animators Training) Programme was organized at KROSS, Bangalore by the CBCI Youth Council from 1st to 10th June, 2017. The programme was attended by 40 participants - youth directors, animators and youth leaders from different dioceses of India.

New Android Mobile App for KRYC

On 11th June 2017, the App was launched by Shri Mathai KAS, Department of Sakaala, Govt. of Karnataka in the presence of Bishop Henry D'Souza, Chairman, CBCI Youth Commission. The event took place at KROSS, Bangalore during the National Council meeting of ICYM (Indian Catholic Youth Movement).

The new Mobile App is meant to reach out to the needy Catholic Youth and to empower them to be tomorrow's leaders in the society through academics, skill training and value education. The App has provision in it to register all the Catholic Youth who are in the age group of 15 and 30 years and to avail the job oriented courses and job opportunities. It is also a platform to be in touch with the youth through sharing of information regarding the youth commissions of the dioceses and the youth movements. "Youth, Faith and Vocational Discernment". In preparation for this great event, the national youth office had passed on a questionnaire to all the Bishops and youth directors. It was supposed to be submitted back in May 2017. Only one diocese has sent the results of the questionnaire so far. May I remind you all to distribute copies of this questionnaire among maximum number of youth and get them filled up and send the results either to the regional office or to the national office, at the earliest.

Regional and Diocesan Elections of ICYM, YCS and Abide

ICYM Regional Elections will be held in the month of December this year. I request all the dioceses to complete the diocesan level elections before November and send the names of the office bearers to the regional office. The diocesan male representative and female representative should have at least one year of experience at diocesan level to contest at the regional election. They should be able to commit themselves for two full years as REXCOs. In the past number REXCOs cease to be the office bearers due to unavailability to the regional level meetings and other reasons. Abide-ICYM Alumni regional office bearers' election also will be held on the same day along with ICYM regional election.

YCS/YSM Regional Elections will be held on 3rd of September at Don Bosco, Chitradurga, Shimoga diocese. Please complete the diocese level elections before 15th August and send the list of the office bearers to the regional office.

In order to facilitate consultation, a questionnaire will be prepared and sent to you all.
